#### A Year of Transformation and Gratitude

The year started with a heightened sense of celebration, having completed the Storm Water Drainage System under budget and on time. This top-priority project of the campaign solved the urgent problem of water in the basement and improved the health of the building and the safety and efficiency of the parking lot. By spring everyone was enjoying the beauty of the new landscaping and seeing the fruits of all our hard work on the campaign. We are very grateful to the George I. Alden Trust, Massachusetts Cultural Council Cultural Facilities Fund, Stoddard Foundation and Amelia Peabody Charitable Trust, who granted the funding to make this project possible.

Paying off the mortgage was another major goal, having started the campaign with the mortgage at \$365,000. By the end of FY2014, the mortgage was down to a little over \$150,000. (A happy update – the mortgage was paid off in full on October 10, 2014 with a \$150,000 campaign gift from the Jeanne Y. Curtis Charitable Trust.)

In May at the Faculty Chamber Music Concerts, we publicly launched the campaign's Recital Hall Expansion Project, the last and most exciting of our campaign capital projects. You will be hearing much more about this in FY2015!

Our donor community is making a vital contribution to the entire greater Worcester area through their gifts to Joy of Music, which make it possible:

- \* for students unable to pay tuition to study at the school through the Financial Aid Program,
- \* to provide instruments through our Instrument Fund to students who can't afford one,
- \* to support our talented faculty as performing artists through Faculty Concert Sponsorships,
- \* to improve and expand the learning environment through capital projects, and
- \* for the school to plan strategically for the future through operating and endowment gifts.

Our heart-felt thanks to everyone at JOMP for their enthusiastic work and the depth of their commitment to the school this past year - from our hard-working staff to the students, faculty, parents, volunteers, Board of Directors and donors. It is a privilege to work with such a dedicated community of people.

## **Program Highlights**

Joy of Music served 510 students in FY2014, 303 in private lessons and 207 in classes and ensembles. \$128,004 in financial aid made it possible for 96 students to study at JOMP who could not afford it otherwise. Financial aid is the primary tool that enables us to realize our mission "to enrich lives and foster community through accessible music education and performance." The positive impact of including everyone regardless of income reaches far beyond the students receiving assistance. Their participation not only brightens their lives, it enriches the entire JOMP community and invigorates all our educational programs.





For example, our Youth Sinfonietta (pictured left), Youth Orchestra, Jazz Ensembles and Children's Chorus would not be viable without our Financial Aid Program, which makes it possible for 30% to 80% of their membership to participate.

Our partnership with Worcester Housing Authority continued with students from Great Brook Valley participating in summer Keyboard and World Drumming classes and Children's Chorus and

Creative Movement during the academic year. The Burncoat Quadrant Initiative, in its sixth year, strengthens and supports public schools in JOMP's neighborhood. Twenty-eight students from six elementary schools and Burncoat Middle and Senior High Schools received need-based financial aid for private lessons, ensembles and orchestra.

Performances: Students and faculty gave a total of 73 performances at JOMP and in the community, reaching a combined audience of over 14,000 people:






